Clinical Prep & Clinical Log Instructions

(NOTE: These may vary for different Health Science teachers.)

Senior Clinical Prep:

You will be informed of the day that the clinical prep is to be completed by your Health Science teacher. This day will usually be the same every week. **This assignment is to be handwritten.**

1. You are to use the computer lab (Internet) as part of this assignment, as well as textbook, and other resources that will be provided to you.
2. This assignment requires a minimum of 2 Internet sources and 1 textbook (book) source. List these sources at the bottom of your prep.
3. Using the Internet and your textbook resources, find out the following information about the HCW/Technician/Employee in the area you will be shadowing:
 - a. Educational requirements (minimum)
 - b. Highest degree available in field
 - c. Starting wage/salary (range)
 - d. Is there a career ladder in this field?
 - e. Local/State educational facilities offering needed courses for this field
4. List 10 questions you would consider asking the healthcare worker/technician/employee. These questions are to be appropriate questions. Be careful to avoid personal or embarrassing questions. Your questions can be general, but approximately 50% of your questions should be related to the area you are shadowing.
5. The assignment is due at the end of the Directed Study period. Your Health Science teacher may not actually collect this assignment, but will ensure that it is completed. You are then to review your findings thoroughly, so you will be prepared for your clinical/shadowing experience.

Senior Clinical Log:

You will be informed of the day that the clinical log is to be turned in to your Health Science teacher. This day will usually be the same every week.

1. The log will be handwritten on the first day back to class after your last clinical of the week. This is usually on Monday. You will write the log during class time.
2. The log will be due at the end of the first period you are in class.
3. You MUST:
 - a. **Legibly** handwritten your clinical log
 - b. Use a black ink pen
 - c. Rewrite questions from clinical log form
 - d. Answer all questions/statements in complete sentences (two sentence minimum)
 - e. No one word answers will be accepted
 - f. Staple completed cover sheet (NEATLY hand-written)
4. **You are to turn in your clinical prep with your clinical log.**
